## Hours and Visiting the Grounds of Our Lady

### Cemetery Grounds

The cemetery grounds at 330 Berry Lane will be open Dawn-to-Dusk, seven days a week. The cemetery grounds fall under the mandate for public gatherings. No more than 10 people can congregate in a group, and social distancing should be kept at six-feet apart. The caretaker will be monitoring all visitors who enter the gates of Our Lady and anyone who does not abide by the social distancing mandate will be asked to leave the cemetery and will also be reported to authorities.

Our Lady asks all families to be respectful of the COVID-19 mandates in order to keep everyone safe and virus free. Please do your part to help keep the gates of Our Lady open for our families who wish to visit their loved ones buried in the cemetery.

## Our Lady Is Showing Signs of Spring


